Well reached 1238' where pipe became stuck. Backed off at 1030' leaving in the hole a fish consisting of one four inch collar, seven 5 inch collars and one 6 1/4" bit. Top of fish of 1030 feet, bit at 1190 feet. Verbal permission received to plug and abandon with 10 sacks cement on top of fish, 10 sacks over casing shoe at 202 feet and 5 sacks at the surface. Cementing operations completed 0300 hours February 3, 1980. Plan to skid rig 60 feet to east, set 8 5/8" casing to 450 feet and drill with air to basement.
