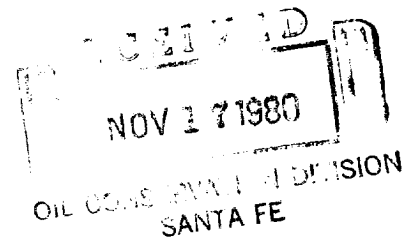

Gentlemen:

Although the locations of the wells (L-7-13N-18E) in the captioned locality are very rough and badly rutted, Mr. Culbertson - landowner - has agreed to accept the sites as being sufficiently "restored", and will not insist upon the additional cleaning or levelling which could have been expected.

In order for the files to be closed, this agency should have some additional data, required by law and specified by Rule 202, a copy of which is attached. This data consists of a copy of the bore-hole surveys, a Form C-105 for the No. 1 well, and Forms C-103, "Subsequent Report of Plug and Abandonment" for both wells.
