"The report shall give the date the work was started and the date it was completed; a detailed account of the manner in which the work was performed; the nature and quantities of materials used in plugging, and the depths and lengths of the various plugs; records of any tests or measurements made; the amount, size and depth of all casing left in the well; the volume and gravity of mud-laden fluid used; pressures retained in mudding; a completed record of any shooting done; and names; addresses and positions of all those in charge of the work.

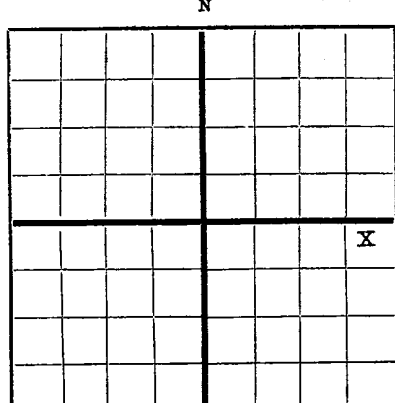
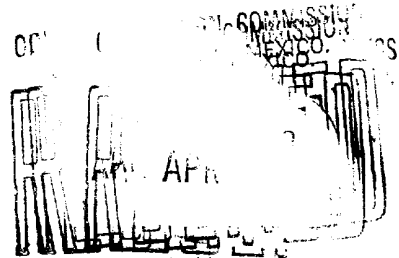
