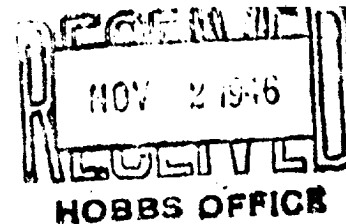

Cemented with 600 sacks Dewey 24 hour cement. Cement circulated. Job complete 10:50 P M 10-18-46. Casing tested OK before and after drilling plug.
