In accordance with my telephone conversation with Mr. Thomas on August 30, 1961, concerning the possibility of calling a hearing to allow Ledge Petroleum Company to show cause why the subject well should not be plugged, the docket for our hearing on September 20th was held open until this date. Inasmuch as I have heard nothing further from Mr. Thomas concerning this matter, a show cause hearing has not been docketed.

As stated in my letter of August 10, 1961, the Commission will expect the subject well to be plugged by October 1, 1961. Mr. Kapteina, District Engineer for the Commission, should be consulted concerning an appropriate plugging program for the well and given the opportunity to witness its plugging.
