Gentlemen:

With reference to your letter of October 26, 1959 in which the Commission granted the temporarily abandoned status of the subject well be extended to April 18, 1960, please be advised that we are at the present moment completing final details for the drilling of another well near the vicinity of the subject well, as outlined in our previous request. Drilling commitments in newly acquired leases require the next well to be commenced on or before June 1, 1960, and for this reason we once again request the Commission's permission that our Sedberry #1 well be placed on a temporarily abandoned status for an additional six months until the drilling of the second well can be completed, and at which time would place us in a position to re-enter and deepen subject well.

Should your office require Conservation Commission Form C-102 to support our request, please advise and same will be forthcoming.

Any consideration you may extend to our request for an additional extension of time will be very much appreciated.

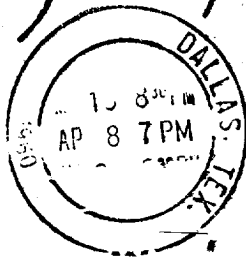
