Please refer to your letter of September 29, 1953, with inquiry as to what attorney presented J. H. Blackstone's blanket plugging bond (with National Surety Corporation as surety) to this office.

We have no records which might show this. However, we have checked with the local agent, James Russell Agency, and Mr. R. E. Beardsley of that office says that Blackstone had no attorney in applying for the bond; he readily recalled that the bond was executed personally by Mr. Blackstone.

This is true in many cases. In other words, it is not necessary for an attorney to handle a bond application, but the surety and principal alone can handle it.

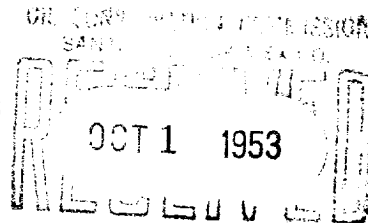
