For some time the scout reports reflect no activity with regard to the above captioned well - reciting that the well is in schist at 745 ft. That would seem to indicate that there would be no point in drilling further. You should, therefore, proceed to plug the well in accordance with the requirements of the Commission. You may apply to Roy Yarbrough, Oil & Gas Inspector, Hobbs, New Mexico, for a set of plugging papers and instructions regarding plugging.

I trust it will not be necessary to call upon your surety.
