Kill CO₂ zone about 1970-1988 by pumping mud into formation.

6 3/16 casing in well from about 600 to 1600. Fill with heavy mud to top with 10 ft of top of 6 3/16. 15 sx plug at this point which will reach well into open hole. Fill with mud to 530 and 15 sx plug at this point. From this plug to surface to be plugged to satisfaction of State Engineer's Office.
