By letter dated September 21, 1967, you were requested to plug Lee Burns "A" Well No. 1 within 15 days. By letter dated September 24, 1967, you requested 60 days or so to finish completion work. By telephone conversation on September 26, 1967, it was agreed that the 60-day period would be granted, but, you would attempt to resume operations on said well within 15 days. If you are unable to resume operations within 15 days you will then file a request for temporary abandonment, it was intended that you would, in a diligent manner, attempt to resume operations within the 15 days. Also, it was agreed that you would place additional cement behind the 5 1/2-inch casing before additional testing is made to make certain that the water zone at approximately 300 feet is isolated from the zones being tested, this should also be included on the form C-103.

Request for temporary abandonment should be filed for separately and, when you resume operations, please file another form showing completion work intended.

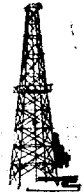
