In accordance with our agreement over the telephone this morning, I am writing you in regard to the above captioned wells.

We have located the driller's affidavit stating precisely the manner in which the Gossum well in Hidalgo County was plugged, and on this date authorize this bond to be released inasmuch as the plugging is satisfactory.

All of the requirements of the Umbarger State No. 1 have been met and this well is considered as belonging to the Bigbee Brothers and I am authorizing the plugging bond to be cancelled on this well.

The Cardinal Oil Company No. 1 file is not complete. As agreed in our conversation this morning you will file with us form C-105, drillers log, and form C-103, results of plugging well, stating exactly the way this well was plugged. Upon completion of this, the bond on this well will be released allowing you to use this well as a water well. In order to make our file complete, and inasmuch as the information is not too plentiful regarding the Cardinal well, I would like to have your receipts from Halliburton on the work that they did, as this will be of considerable assistance to you and to us should anyone question the method by which this well was plugged.

I believe this brings us up to date on our activities.

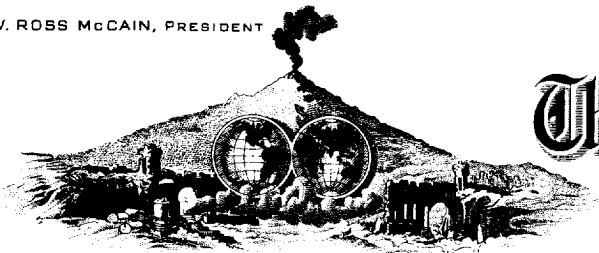

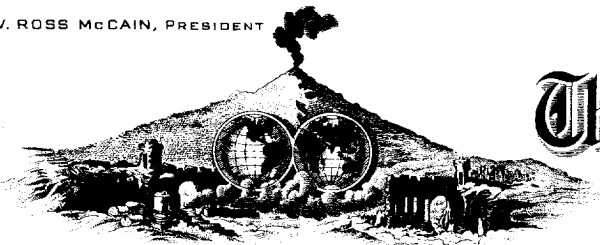

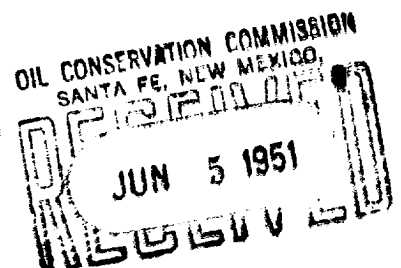
