Dear Mr. Jarrell:

Reference is made to your application dated August 11, 1995 for an unorthodox Bravo Dome carbon dioxide gas well location in an existing standard 640-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide (640-acre) Gas Pool comprising all of Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 34 East, NMPM, Union County, New Mexico. Said 640-acre unit is currently dedicated to the Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit Well No. 1934-161L (API No. 30-059-20009), located 1650 feet from the South line and 450 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 16.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Bravo dome 640-Acre Area*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-7556, dated June 19, 1984, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox carbon dioxide gas well location, is hereby approved:

Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit Well No. 1934-162J
1999'FSL - 2574'FEL (Unit J) of said Section 16
API No. 30-059-20344

Also, as provided by Rule 4 of said special rules, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide (640-acre) Gas Pool production from the Bravo Dome Carbon Dioxide Gas Unit Well No. 1934-162J with the No. 1934-161L well on the subject 640-acre spacing unit.
