Dear Sir:

We are enclosing forms you will need for the drilling of a projected wildcat well in Union County, New Mexico. The first requisite is the furnishing of a plugging bond to this Commission. For one well, a \$5,000.00 one-well plugging bond is adequate, or, if you prefer, you may obtain a \$10,000.00 blanket bond, which is designed to cover any number of wells. The plugging bond is necessary only if your well is on state or privately owned land, and must be approved by this office before your well is spudded.

The C-101 form, or Notice of Intention to Drill, is next required. This should be filed as directed with this office, which is headquarters for District 4, from which Union County work is handled. Forms C-103 and C-102 are to be filed as indicated during the progress of your work.

We will be awaiting further word from you regarding the beginning of your operations. Please advise us as to how your field representative may be contacted, as a representative of the Commission will from time to time visit the location.
