Pursuant to correspondence from Mr. R. S. Skinner,
a Raton attorney representing Gruenmer Indian Carbonic, Ltd.
I am under the impression that you wish to be relieved of all
plugging responsibility as regards your \$5,000.00 one-well
bond covering the above captioned well.

I want to refer you to your Report on Deepening Well,
Oil Conservation Commission Form C-103, as filed by you in
person on June 23, 1952 and as approved by me on that same date.
Specifically you were to furnish this office with data on the
perforation job done by Lane - Wells. This has never been re-
ceived here. Similarly the well file is lacking a well record
as ordinarily submitted on our Form C-105. It is very relevant
and essential that you submit to this office any of the above
datum which you might have at your disposal.

Please understand our position on this matter. The
information on any well is only as complete as the operator on
that well submits it to us.

Now I am aware of the fact that Mr. Henry C. Gruenmer
of Wilton Junction, Iowa has taken over your leases in the Des
Moines area including the above captioned well and that he is
now operating under a blanket bond. Nonetheless your
