The Form C-103 - result of plugging, probably is in the mail, if so, please disregard this request.

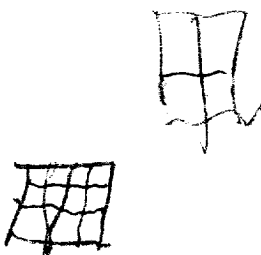
