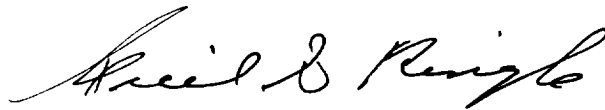

Dear Mr. Yarbrough:-

Your letter of June 2nd, 1947. I shall attempt to make this clear to you, (The application in question called No#3 well) Our No #2 which was drilled in Section 35, and permission given to make a water well has been completed for a water well, however, not yet equipped. On March 31st, 1947 you approved application to drill No#3 well offsetting this No#2 in Section 35. We did not drill this well, and in my letter of May 27th, I merely asked to switch this location to Section 34, which is offsetting No#1 well. No #1 well has been drilled to a depth of 827 feet, and is yet in question if we shall do more work with it or plug and abandon, but at present are using it as a water well to drill this No#3.

Hoping this clarifies this situation, and that I may hear from you at once, as we are already rigged up and ready to start spudding.
