This well has elevated levels of contaminants that are climbing the deeper the samples go at S1 going from 6700 at 1 foot to 13000 at 4 foot. It shows the same at S5 going from 740 at 4 foot to 1340 at 6 foot. Because of this I researched AFMSS to look at the history of spills on this location and this is the only reported spill. As a result of this information the areas must be fully delineated to obtain the depth that the contaminants for this location for the well files history of contaminates. This does not mean that more soil needs to be removed because by doing so would be a hazard to personal but we need to record clean up depths. If required you

may shift the sample points to avoid underground power lines or pipes. If you have any questions feel free to call me anytime.
