Hi Mike,

This leak was discovered in mid-March this year. The tanks in the earthen containment have been removed. I have attached the initial C-141 and a packet with data collected at the site as of today.

We have chloride impact greater than 1000 ppm beneath the former location of the tank to about 12 to 14 feet bgs. Beneath that, we have been able to delineate to a depth of 24 feet with an excavator inside the 5 foot excavation and have determined that all deeper samples consistently show field screens of 680 ppm and decreasing to 420 ppm. BOPCO proposes to remove all impacted soils above 1000 ppm and backfill the site with topsoil and cap with caliche.
