Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The release impacted approximately 11,000 sq. ft. of caliche well pad with mostly produced water and misted approximately 15,000 sq. ft. of pasture area with crude oil. The pasture area was treated with micro-blaze. Soil samples were collected, analyzed and based on laboratory analytical results the release area has been excavated and contaminated soil hauled to a state approved disposal facility. A liner was installed over the areas of SP6 and SP7 then the excavation was backfilled with clean soil. The area has been remediated in accordance with the NMOCD and BLM remediation guidelines.
