Hi Mike,

Good talking with you this afternoon. Per our discussion, due to the high traffic area in the vicinity of the leak and the congestion of surface lines, we will continue the 4 foot excavation as far west from the release point as possible before interfering with Gavalin Rd traffic. The surface staining to the north of the release point and also any surface staining to the east will be removed. The excavation will be backfilled with clean soil. The samples following the center of Gavalin Rd. show that the worst of the chloride is held to the upper few inches to a foot below ground surface and continue to decrease in the lower profile. For this reason, and the Gavalin Rd traffic issue, the road samples will remain in-situ. Please call me with any questions/concerns.
