Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.

Well was down and the circulating pump was running, causing fluid to flow to the heater treater so the valve released. This resulted in a loss and spill of approximately 150 BBLS of Crude. A vacuum truck was utilized to recover approximately 60 BBLS of fluid. SESI was retained to remediate the site.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.

The impacted soils were removed to an NMOCD approved facility and the site remediated in accordance with the approved remediation plan. SESI on behalf of OXY respectfully requests closure of this incident.
