The OCD approves this work plan. In addition to the BLM stipulation, the OCD has a few more:

- A reevaluation of the depth to ground water is required. Per the ChevronTexaco Trend map and OSE database, ground water is potentially quite shallow;
- A 4 foot excavation will be necessary at SP7 and SP10;
- SP12 will need further delineation;
- SP15 will need further delineation and a deeper excavation (dependent on delineation information);
- A 3 foot excavation will be required at all other points.
