The following *Final Closure Report* serves as a condensed update on closure activities for the above referenced Site.

Background Information:

A hole developed on the water leg of the main heater treater, releasing 10 barrels of oil to the lined containment. One barrel of oil was released outside of the containment (very light mist) to location. A vacuum truck was called to the location and recovered 10 barrels of oil from the lined containment.

Remediation Activities:

EPI personnel mobilized on the site on September 22, 2015 to scrape up the release areas outside the containment. No soil samples were collected from the release areas as only a light misting of oil had occurred (reference *Figure 3*).

The release area on the west side of containment was excavated to a depth of six (6) inches bgs while the release area on the east side of containment, on pad area, was scraped up. Approximately 6 tons of contaminated soil was excavated and hauled to a state approved facility for disposal.

Closure Activities:

On September 22, 2015 the excavation was backfilled with approximately 6 tons of clean soil. All soil was free of rocks, clumps or deleterious material. The entire disturbed area was then contoured to blend with existing pad area and protected against wind/water erosion.

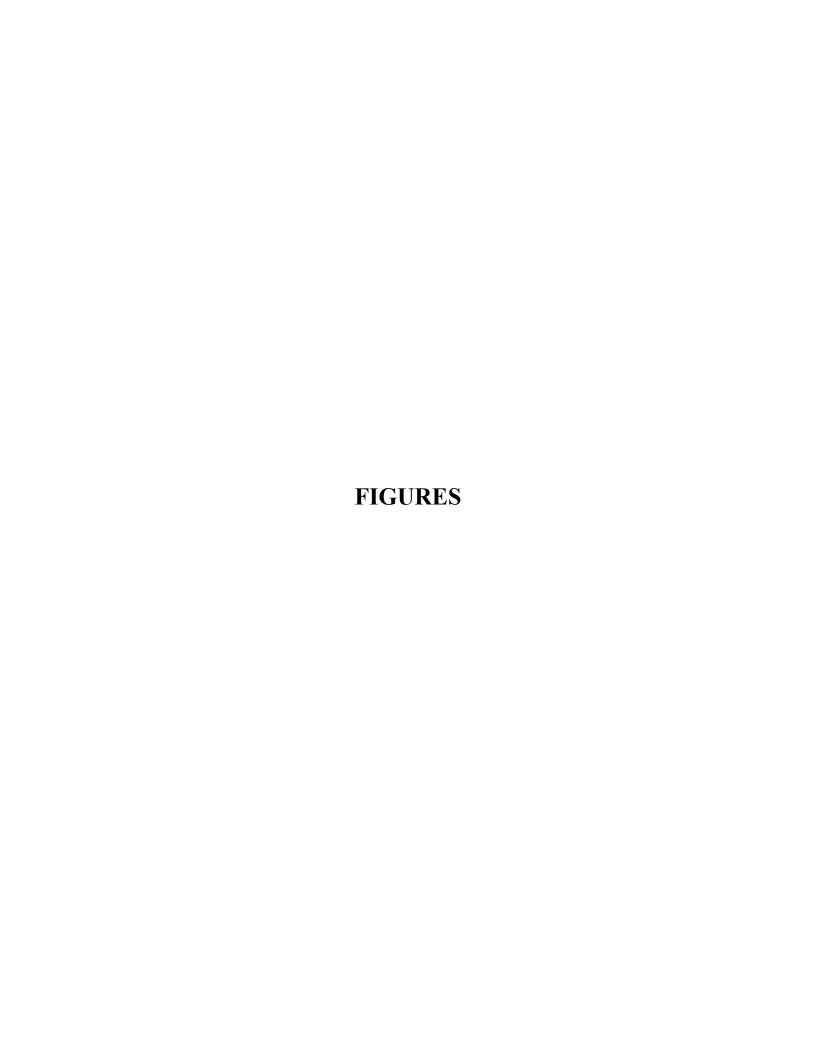


Figure 2 – Site Location Map Figure 3 – Site/Sample Map


