CALLER IS REPORTING A DISCHARGE OF FRESHWATER WITH 2 PERCENT OF POTASSIUM CHLORIDE FROM A TANK ON A FRACK JOB, THE CAUSE WAS DUE TO THE HATCH ON THE BACK OF THE TANK THAT WAS NOT SECURE, CALLER ALSO STATED THAT THERE WAS ABOUT 288 POUNDS OF JELL (GUAR) ADDED TO THE WATER AS WELL THAT DISCHARGED.
