I would prefer the well be installed between soil borings 1 and 2. But, given that they want to excavate, line, and backfill...tell Hack to put the well as close to the probable downgradient side of the excavation as practical. Based on the soil data and the estimated groundwater depth, there will be chloride contamination. And that means more wells will be needed for delineation. It would save time and money if they were put in simultaneously, but that is up to the responsible party.
