Internal corrosion of a steel nipple on the discharge line caused 18 bbls of produced water to leak onto the ground. A vacuum truck recovered 15 bbls of water and the nipple was replaced.

The affected area is inside the lined battery. Remediation was completed by removing the impacted soil from the lined battery and replacing it with clean soil.
