This email is in regards to voicemail left with Crystal Weaver on 2/7/2018 at 5:16 P.M. giving verbal notification of an unauthorized release at the North Brushy 35-6H well pad.

API 30-015-42292, Lat 32.0929574, Long -103.953377

This incident occurred approx. 4 A.M. during the morning of 2/7/2017. A seal on the heater treater fire tube failed and allowed approx. 25 bbls of fluids to be released to the pad surface and land off-location. The impacts to the land off location are misting on to brush and soil. Approx. 10 bbls was able to be recovered.

WPX would like permission to remove the heavily impacted brush and remove 6" of soil from approx. 1 acre of BLM off location land.

A C-141 will be delivered within 15 days. Please let me know if you have any additional questions.
