OCD has received your initial C-141 for RE: Marathon Oil Company- Initial C141- STERLING STATE 23 27 20 TB #004H, WA #006H, thank you. There are issues with the C-141 you submitted and therefore it cannot be processed.

- There is no Latitude/Longitude coordinates. Please provide the exact lat/long where the spill occurred.
- This is a major release (Volume Released 60 barrels)

19.15.29.7 DEFINITIONS:

“Major release” means:

- an unauthorized release of a volume, excluding gases, of 25 barrels or more;
- an unauthorized release of a volume that:
 - results in a fire or is the result of a fire;
 - may with reasonable probability reach a watercourse;
 - may with reasonable probability endanger public health; or
 - substantially damages property or the environment;
- an unauthorized release of gases exceeding 500 MCF; or
- a release of a volume that may with reasonable probability be detrimental to fresh water.

“Minor release” means an unauthorized release, which is not a major release and is a volume greater than five barrels but less than 25 barrels; or for gases, greater than 50 MCF but less than 500 MCF.

Please, correct The C-141 and send it again. However, as of today July 1st, application for administrative approval of a release notification and corrective action will require the operator to go to <https://wwwapps.emnrd.state.nm.us/OCD/OCDPermitting/Default.aspx> and provide payment for review of forms and/or review of documents. Also, in order to ease some of the transition, NMOCD has put a [FAQ announcement](#) on our website.

We are considering your email as an initial notification for a major release.
