On behalf of XTO, please see the attached closure report for the Corral Canyon Central Tank Battery (2RP-5466). The report has been uploaded to the NMOCD permitting portal (PO#: 405HN-191115-C-1410).

BLM Summary:

On May 18, 2019, a leaking valve caused a release of approximately 45 barrels (bbls) of produced water into a temporary lined containment. A vacuum truck recovered all of the fluid that was released and XTO conducted a liner integrity inspection. The liner was determined to be compromised and additional investigation activities were required. Once the temporary containment was removed, delineation soil samples PH01/PH01A through PH05/PH05A were collected from within the release extent from depths of 1 foot and 2 feet bgs to assess for the presence or absence of soil impacts. Laboratory analytical results for all soil samples indicated benzene, BTEX, GRO and DRO, TPH, and chloride concentrations were compliant with the Closure Criteria. XTO requests no further action for RP Number 2RP-5466.
