On November 13, 2019, an estimated release of 340 barrels of crude oil occurred at the Holly Energy Partners (HEP) Millman Station. Approximately 275 barrels of oil were recovered by vacuum truck and disposed at an NMOCD approved facility. The site is located in Unit Letter G, Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The NMOCD was notified of the release on November 13, 2019 and the initial C-141 was submitted on December 18, 2019, following resolution of a technical delay with the NMOCD reporting portal. The approved initial C-141 was received by HEP on January 29, 2020 and the site was assigned the NMOCD Tracking No.: NRM2002952961. A copy of the initial C-141 is attached.

Delineation activities were conducted at the site from December 10 to 12, 2019. Laboratory results indicate that further investigation is necessary to complete vertical delineation of TPH impacts.

HEP respectfully requests a three month extension (until May 13, 2020) for submittal of the Remediation Workplan to the NMOCD.
