Mr. Raley,

The OCD has approved the Remediation Plan for incident # NAB1927729096 LONGVIEW FEDERAL 12 #015H @ 30-015-41092 2RP-5647 with the following conditions of approval:

- OCD approves a sampling plan variance for collecting 5 point composite confirmation sidewall samples and bottom samples that shall not represent an area greater than 500 square feet. However, if there is anything that looks suspicious, like a dark spot or a wet decolorated spot, WPX must grab a sample and test it for all the components listed in Table 1. These grab samples must be geotag, -GPS located samples- and clear good quality photographic evidence must be provide
- The proposed variance of: *"...to omit all BTEX analysis for confirmation samples since concentrations did not exceed the Closure Criteria of 50 mg/kg for BTEX. Additionally, WPX is proposing to omit all TPH analysis for confirmation samples collected from the pasture"* is not approved. All confirmation samples must be tested for all the components listed in Table 1.
- Confirmation composite sidewall samples will need to be under the limit of 600 mg/kg for the entire impacted area.
