The OCD has denied the submitted Closure Request C-141 for incident # NCH1903360398 COLE STATE #016 @ 30-025-37721 1RP-5316 for the following reasons:

- More confirmation samples need to be collected from the remediation site. Please see 19.15.29.12 D.(1). Unless approved prior to submitting a closure report, composite samples are expected to be collected representing an area of no more than 200 square feet.
- Operators may request a variance for any requirement of 19.15.29 NMAC. The variance request must include a detailed statement explaining the need for a variance and a detailed written demonstration that the variance will provide equal or better protection of fresh water, public health and the environment
