The OCD has denied the submitted Site Characterization/Remediation Plan C-141 for incident # NRM2014958679 SANDY FEDERAL BATTERY @ P-23-23S-30E ON OE for the following reasons:

- The Depth to groundwater has been incorrectly assessed. When nearby wells are used to determine depth to groundwater, the wells should be no further than ½ mile away from the site, data should be no more than 25 years old, and well construction information should be provided.
- Vertical delineation, which is driven by depth to water, is incomplete because the depth to groundwater has not been established.
- Horizontal delineation has not been completed. Please see 19.15.29.11.5.(b) and (d)
