The OCD has approved the Remediation Plan for incident # NRM2009064906 SALADO DRAW 29 26 33 FEDERAL COM #003H PAD 4 @ 30-025-42638 with the following conditions of approval:

- The Depth to groundwater has not been established. When nearby wells are used to determine depth to groundwater, the wells should be no further than ½ mile away from the site, data should be no more than 25 years old, and well construction information should be provided. If Chevron chooses not to drill a borehole to confirm the depth to groundwater, this site must be remediated to meet the Closure Criteria in Table 1 for groundwater at a depth of 50 feet or less.
- Confirmation samples must be analyzed for the constituents listed in Table 1 of 19.15.29.12. NMAC. i.e. TPH, BTEX, Chloride and Benzene.
