Ms. Venegas:

The release occurred on July 21, 2020. Armstrong has already mobilized to the site and excavated a large quantity of material. Unfortunately, this wasn't done in complete accordance with NMOCD rules, and the closure request was rejected by NMOCD. Therefore, Armstrong requested HRL to assist with conducting a site characterization and developing a remediation plan in accordance with NMOCD rules. HRL completed the site characterization activities on August 15, 2020, which included collection and analysis of 23 soil samples at various depths and latitude/longitude to complete the horizontal and vertical delineation of the impacts at the Site. The data for the site characterization was received by HRL on September 11, 2020. HRL has evaluated the data and discussed the Site and potential remediation options with Armstrong. At this time, Armstrong has requested additional time to discuss the potential remediation options with their internal management prior to selecting an approach to remediate this site. This is primarily due to the complexity of the release impacting soil under and immediately adjacent to an active tank battery.

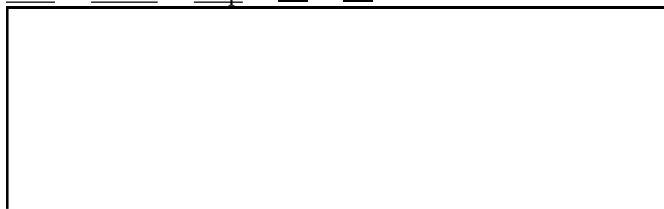

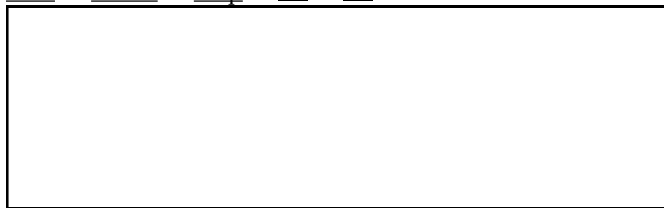
