Fuel hose was replaced, tested and put back in service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* Gerry Guye approved the removal of the affected soil to line the flare pit. The diesel should evaporate during flaring. During tank battery installation and final well pad restoration, the soil will be used in the building of the tank berms.
