Comments on Inspection:

Well sign lists API number as 30-015-527830 which is incorrect in that the second 5 is a misprint. The API number 30-015-27830 is for a well that has a canceled APD. The correct API number for this well is 30-015-33152. Sign is in violation of Rule 103. Some contamination at wellhead area. General clean-up required. No leaks were observed at time of inspection. Reserve pits open with

liner cut and removed above solids.
