Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A driver drove off without disconnecting his load line which caused 30 barrels of produced water to be released. No fluids were recovered. The affected area is approximately 300' x 35'. This release occurred on location and flowed west off location.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Talon/LPE was contracted to perform remedial activities for this release. The impacted area was subsequently excavated to a depth of 1-foot deep. The contaminated soil was disposed of at Lea Land, LLC. The area was re-contoured to match the surrounding location. The lab results are attached along with a site map. The soil testing results are under the Recommended Remedial Action Levels (RRAL's). No further actions are required.
