Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The well was P&A on 2/18/14. A crew started the final reclamation on 6/24/14 after the tanks and equipment had been removed. Heavily impacted soil was discovered around the production tanks and surrounding area.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The total affected area measured approximately 40,000 sq.ft. The investigation began with test trenches and finally ended up with the advancement of 5 soil bores across the impacted area. The final reclamation was discussed with Mike Bratcher and given the spill report #2RP-2724. Per NMOCD approval, the site was excavated to 6 inches north of the former well marker. South of the former well marker, the site was excavated to 2 ft. bgs, lined with 20 mil plastic and backfilled. The site was contoured to surrounding landscape and re-seeded.
