Excess pressure caused the stuffing box packing on the wellhead to blow out 5 bbls of oil and 5 bbls of produced water onto the ground. No fluids were recovered and the stuffing box packing was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 30' x 60' on location. Remediation was completed in accordance with the remediation plan approved by Mike Bratcher of NMOCD via email on 04/09/2014 and approved by Sol Hughes of the BLM via email on 04/13/2014.
