Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* BOPCO EHS was notified of a release that occurred when the threads of a 45 elbow connection failed; the majority of the fluid was contained inside the lined firewall containment, However a small amount of oil was sprayed to the well pad. A vacuum truck was called to the location.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The majority of the fluid was contained inside the lined firewall containment. However a small amount of oil was sprayed to the well pad. A vacuum truck was called to the location and recovered 15 barrels of oil from the lined containment and 1.5 barrels of oil from the ground surface. Samples were collected, and based on laboratory analytical data and NMOCD approval: the contaminated soil was excavated and hauled to a state approved disposal facility, and the excavation backfilled with clean soil.
