Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A one inch injection line ruptured releasing ~20 bbbs produced water with ~15 bbbs recovered. An Emergency Response Team arrived at the release area and began continuous abatement of the impacted area.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 41,800 square feet of area was affected by the release of produced water. Visibly stained soil was excavated and hauled away for disposal at a state approved facility. Soil samples were collected and submitted to Cardinal Laboratories for testing. Having received acceptable lab results and NMOCD approval, the affected area has been backfilled with clean caliche and topsoil and returned to proper conditions.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
