SWD pump did not kick on automatically therefore tanks were ran over. When pumper arrived on location he immediately started swd pump which stopped the leak.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Leak contaminated a 150 ft by 25 ft area west of the tank containment. All fluids stayed on the pad. Contaminated soil will be excavated and hauled to LeaLand. Samples from the pad were taken on November 24, 2014 in connection with 2RP-2534.
