Signage was put in place to notify traffic of work on the shoulder and a permit to work inside of the county's ROW was be obtained. Upon receipt of analytical data a remediation work plan was drafted and subsequently approved by NMOCD and BLM. The remediation proceeded in accordance with the approved work plan. The impacted soil was excavated and disposed of at a NMOCD approved solid waste disposal facility. The excavation was backfilled with caliche and contoured to match the surrounding location.
