

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A compromised 3" poly water transfer line spilled 10 bbls of produced water off location. No fluids were recovered and the line was repaired.

The affected area is approximately 25' x 25' approximately 700 feet east of location. Remediation was completed in accordance with the remediation plan approved for the release (2RP-3946) by Shelly Tucker of the BLM on 11/21/2016 and Mike Bratcher of the NMOCD on 11/29/2016.
