A hole in the bottom of the tank cause 20 bbls of produced water to leak onto the lined facility. The fluids were recovered and the tank was repaired.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 20' x 20' on location inside the lined containment. Remediation was completed by removing the impacted soil covering the liner and replacing it with clean material. The liner integrity was inspected and verified to be intact. Picture attached.
