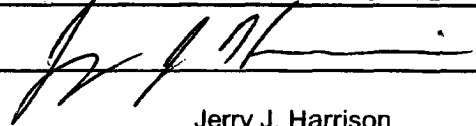
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken. (Attach Additional Sheets if Necessary)

Flowline leak, small hole in bottom of pipe probably external corrosion from laying on wet soil. Shut in well and isolated line, called vac truck when arrived vacuumed up standing fluid and disposed of at the Indian Hills SWD. The bad section of line will be replaced and put up on blocks to prevent contact with the ground.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken. (Attach Additional Sheets if Necessary)

Low lying area east of the facility production header, grazing land, area had just dried up prior to storm the day before which left some standing water in area. Vacuumed up all standing fluid.
