Yates Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests that no remedial work be done on the production string cement. Cement did not circulate to surface on the 5 1/2 casing string. Top of cement is at 375'. An electronic copy of the Bond Log was sent to the BLM office on 9-14-12. Slips were set on the 5 1/2" casing and then cemented. Slips cannot be pulled to one inch cement to surface. However, a gauge will be installed in the 5 1/2 and 9 5/8 annulus to monitor pressure. If pressure is noted, then BLM will be notified.
