The NMOCD District 2 office is in receipt of an Initial Report C-141 reporting an illegal dumping of produced fluids event that occurred at the above referenced site on June 11, 2005. The estimated release volume was reported to be 100 bbls with an estimated 20 bbls recovered.

The NMOCD, along with most of the Oil and Gas industry, is actively involved in attempting to identify companies and individuals that operate in this manner. We will use all means at our disposal to impose fines and or restrictions on companies that allow this type of activity to occur.

Due to the shallow ground water located in this area, the OCD feels that delineation and possible remediation of contaminants is required. At this time, our only recourse is to request the operator of record of the lease to perform this action.

Please delineate the vertical and horizontal extent of contamination and formulate a remediation work plan based on this information and NMOCD guidelines. Remediation guidelines may be found on the NMOCD website as follows: www.emnrd.state.nm.us/ocd (Publications/Environmental Handbook/Miscellaneous Guidelines/Spill Prevention Clean Up).

Please contact the NMOCD District 2 office 24 hours prior to commencement of activities and 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analysis of samples are to be submitted to the NMOCD.
