Closure work plan for drilling pit. The drilling pit will be capped and encapsulated insitu. This will be accomplished by mixing earthen materials with the pit contents, as necessary to stiffen the pit contents sufficiently to provide physical stability and support for the pit cover. The edges of the liner will be folded over the stiffened mud and cuttings; capping the pit with a 20 mil thickness impervious; reinforced synthetic liner meeting ASTM standards that is designed to be resistant to the material encapsulated; and covering the cap with a minimum of 3' feet of clean soil or like material that is capable of supporting native plant growth.
A one call and a 48-hour notice will be provided to the Oil Conservation Division.

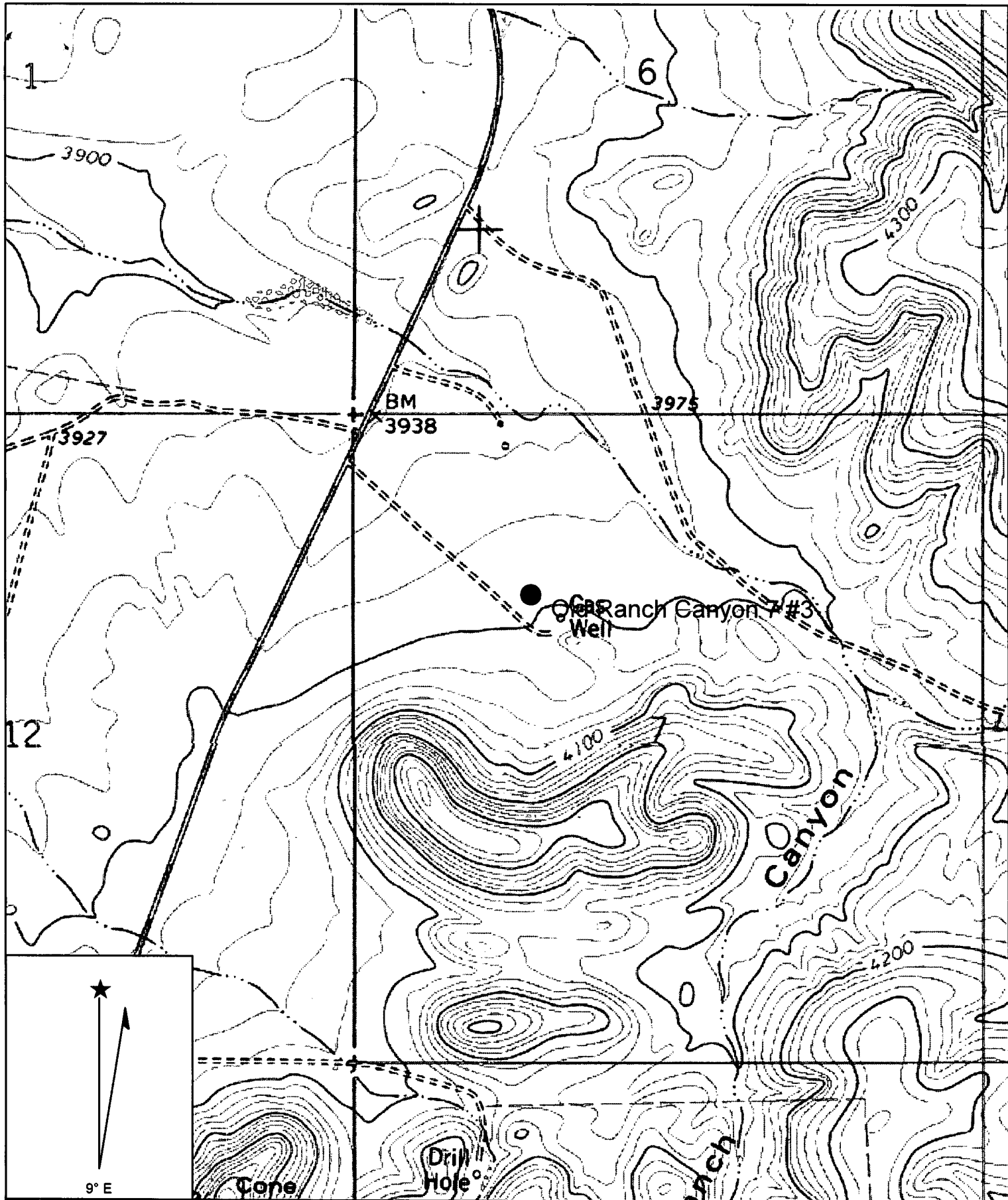
